A Crash Course In Fiber

Everything you need to know about Fiber in 30 Seconds

What is fiber?

Fiber to the Home (FTTH) technology allows telecommunications services to be transported over fiber optic cables—the best technology available. The average home has five connected devices, all of which need sufficient bandwidth to connect to the Internet. By 2020, the average household will have 50 devices that connect to the Internet. Fiber has virtually unlimited capacity to bring telephone, Internet, digital television, and other services to your home or business with very high quality and reliability.

La Jicarita brings fiber to you

We have been working hard to supply our community with Fiber to the Home so you can experience the fastest speeds and most reliable Internet available. In Mora we have 757 customers connected to fiber, which spreads across 109 miles. Wagon Mound has 365 homes successfully connected, covering over 89 miles. We have also completed a FTTH project on County Rd. C-001 Cebolla Canyon /County Rd.C-044 Canoncito (inclusive to the Mora Health Community Center Clinic).

Future plans for Fiber

We are currently working on a Fiber to the Home project on NM Hwy 434 - commencing on Intersection NM 518 and heading out approximately (6) miles north on NM 434. If you are not yet connected to the fiber network, we hope to bring fiber to your neighborhood as soon as possible.
